With the neighbourhood subsidy ("Grätzlförderung"), WieNeu+supports house owners who want to implement innovative solutions for future-proof and climate-friendly buildings in the project area "Grätzl 20+2".

The implementation of innovative solutions is funded with up to 500,000 Euro. The funding rate for the selected (innovative) measures is between 50 and 70 percent and depends on the size of the company. In addition, planning measures (preliminary or feasibility studies) for such ideas can also be funded with up to 30,000 Euro.
